

Let's Make a Mobile

You will need

to design your mobile, decide how many sticks and sheep you need Print out of as many pairs of lambs that you need

Glue

Scissors

thread

sticks or straws

felt pen (optional)

wool (cotton wool/curly paper strips/wool collected from a field* near you)

*Do Not Take Your Dog!

How

- 1. Colour the sheep's face black if you wish
- 2. Cut out the correct number of sheep for your design
- 3. Glue a thread to the back of one of each pair of sheep
- 4. Glue each pair back to back
- 5. Glue some cotton wool on both sides of each sheep
 Or take a strip of paper about 1 cm wide and curl it round a pencil cut it into short lengths and glue pieces to give sheep a curly fleece
- 6. Tie a sheep to the end of each straw/stick with its thread
- 7. Tie a thread to the middle of the top stick ready to hana up.

Little Lamb, who made thee?

He is called by thy name,

I a child & thou a lamb,
