

let's Play a Game!

YOU WILL NEED:

A caterpillar and a straw for each player A table or floor (no carpets) A start line and a finish line A set of Butterflies

AIM: To collect as many Butterflies as you can

RULES: Each player lines up his caterpillar behind the start line Using the straw, blow your caterpillar towards the finish line

To get a butterfly, your caterpillar must be the first to touch the finish line with the head (not side-ways, not backwards)

Return to the start line and repeat moves till all the butterflies have

been won. The player with the most butterflies is the WINNER!



Make a caterpillar. Cut a strip of paper 4.5 cm x 21cm. Fold the paper end to end 3 times. Round off the corners with scissors. Open up the paper and make sure the folds are all pointing upwards except the first and the last. Draw a face on the first segment of the caterpillar.

Make a straw. Cut a piece of A4 paper in half diagonally. Place a pencil across the corner (apex) and roll the paper around the pencil towards the long side of the triangle. Glue the edge and hold firm till it dries. Shake out the pencil and trim the ends.
