



## Instructions for 3D picture of the Prodigal Son

## You need:

copy craft scissors glue coloured pens





## What to do:

- 1. Colour the pictures of the Father and the son and cut them out. Colour the ring and robe.
- 2. Cut out the two large rectangles and fold along lines as shown
- 3. Cut along snip lines on the green/blue rectangle to make tabs. Fold the tabs forwards and backwards then back into place.
- 4. Fold the sides forwards reversing previous fold. As you fold push the tabs forward as far as it will go so the tab lies under the fold.
- 5. Put glue on the front of each tab and stick the son on the left and the Father on the right.
- 6. Glue the blank sides of the 2 rectangles together so the fold lines of each rectangle match. DO NOT GLUE THE TABS
- 7. With the picture of the Father & son facing you fold the gates inward so they close. When they open you should see a 3D picture of the Father welcoming his son home just like God the Father welcomes his repentant children.
