Let's make a sheep bank to keep our coins safe so we don't lose them and a sheep to remind us that Jesus is so happy when he finds one of his lost sheep.

You will need:

I plastic bottle with lid. glue coloured pens or pencils

cotton wool

scissors


card: 4 strips 1cm x 4cm

copy of sheep's face unless you want to draw your own. It's better on card or cut 2 and glue them together for strength.


- 1. Decide where to cut the slit for your coins. The slit should be about 3cm long. Maybe you should ask a responsible adult to do this for you.
- 2. Make 4 feet. Colour your 1x4 strips of card and glue in a circle. Stuff some cotton wool into each foot leaving some sticking out of the top to glue onto your bottle like this.
- 3. Stick cotton wool or paper curls all over the bottle but don't cover the slit.
- 4. Make a tail and stick it onto the cap as a tail.
- 5. Colour and cut out the sheep's face and stick some cotton wool on top of the head, then glue the face to the bottom of the bottle. Something like this
- 6. Keep your coins safe.
- 7. Remember what Jesus said, "...there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
